Verse List (KJV)

- () Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. (Psalm 51:1)
- () Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. (Psalm 51:2)
- () For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. (Psalm 51:3)
- () Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest. (Psalm 51:4)
- () Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom. (Psalm 51:6)
- () Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. (Psalm 51:7)
- () Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. (Psalm 51:10)
- () O Lord, open thou my lips; and my mouth shall shew forth thy praise. (Psalm 51:15)
- () I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. (Exodus 20:2)
- () Thou shalt have no other gods before me. (Exodus 20:3)
- () Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: (Exodus 20:4)
- () Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; (Exodus 20:5)
- () And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. (Exodus 20:6)

() Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. (Exodus 20:7)

() Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. (Exodus 20:8)

() Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: (Exodus 20:9)

() But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: (Exodus 20:10)

() For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it. (Exodus 20:11)

() Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. (Exodus 20:12)

() Thou shalt not kill. (Exodus 20:13)

() Thou shalt not commit adultery. (Exodus 20:14)

() Thou shalt not steal. (Exodus 20:15)

() Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour. (Exodus 20:16)

() Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's. (Exodus 20:17)

() In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. (Genesis 1:1)

() The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. (Psalm 19:1)

() Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge. (Psalm 19:2)

() There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard. (Psalm 19:3)

() Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun, (Psalm 19:4)

() Which is a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoiceth as a strong man to run a race. (Psalm 19:5)

() His going forth is from the end of the heaven, and his circuit unto the ends of it: and there is nothing hid from the heat thereof. (Psalm 19:6)

() The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. (Psalm 19:7)

() The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. (Psalm 19:8)

() The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. (Psalm 19:9)

() More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. (Psalm 19:10)

() Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward. (Psalm 19:11)

() Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the LORD. (Colossians 3:20)

() Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD. (Joshua 24:14)

() And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the god which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD. (Joshua 24:15)

() He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (Psalm 91:1)

() I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. (Psalm 91:2)

() Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. (Psalm 91:3)

() He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. (Psalm 91:4)

() Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; (Psalm 91:5)

() Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday. (Psalm 91:6)

() A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee. (Psalm 91:7)

() Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. (Psalm 91:8)

() Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; (Psalm 91:9)

() There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. (Psalm 91:10)

() For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. (Psalm 91:11)

() They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. (Psalm 91:12)

() Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet. (Psalm 91:13)

() Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. (Psalm 91:14)

() He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. (Psalm 91:15)
